Oak Park residents are invited to attend a community meeting to review site plan concepts and provide input regarding the current and future use of the grounds surrounding Cheney Mansion. Community input is vital to master plan development to ensure the Park District is meeting the current parks and recreation needs of the community, as well as anticipating future needs.

Cheney Mansion, designed in 1913 by Charles E. White, Jr., has been a historical property of the Park District of Oak Park since 1975. It is a unique venue for recreation programs, special activities and community events for the enjoyment of Oak Park residents and a distinctive locale for private meetings and celebrations. The Cheney Mansion Site Plan will only address the 2 acres of landscaped grounds surrounding the Mansion which include a coach house and greenhouse.
