

4th and Final Community Meeting for Mills Park Site Plan

Oak Park residents are invited to attend the fourth and final community meeting to review the site plan draft recommendation and provide input regarding the current and future use of Mills Park. Community input is vital to master plan development to ensure the Park District is meeting the current parks and recreation needs of the community, as well as anticipating future needs.

From Friday, November 14 through Monday, November 24, an online questionnaire will be available at www.oakparkparks.com to collect input regarding the site plan concepts under consideration.

Historic Pleasant Home, a U.S. National Historic landmark located within the park, was sold to the Park District by the family of its second owners, Herbert Mills, in 1939. Mills Park is named in his honor. Although owned by the Park District, Historic Pleasant Home is operated by the Pleasant Home Foundation and is not a part of the site master plan development. The Mills Park Site Master Plan will only address the land surrounding Historic Pleasant Home.
