Oak Park residents are invited to attend a community meeting to learn about the facility and site planning process beginning for Ridgeland Common, the Park District's flagship facility.

A recent existing conditions study concluded the current Ridgeland Common facility is physically and functionally obsolete requiring extensive renovation within the next five years.

The plan being developed by Bonestroo Sports Group, in cooperation with local architects from Nagle Hartray Danker Kagan McKay Penney Architects, Ltd., will provide a blueprint for future park renewal.
