



The following are comments provided by residents in response to the presentation of three concepts:

Concept A:

Move the fence currently shown west of the walk to the right of the walk.  
Like the curved public walk and how it creates additional space for the soccer field and invites users into the park.  
Interpretive signage highlighting Hans Christian Andersen and his work are a positive element and educational about the origin of the park's name.  
Like additional landscape to north of soccer field and having a park sign at the intersection.  
Play area rather small. Equipment theme ok.  
Concerns over maintenance of sand play and like reduced area of sand surface.

Concept B:

Dislike grid of memorial trees. Looser configuration preferred.  
Concerns about creating hiding places behind boulders and between the fence and berm.  
Like the roll hill but not into sand and not towards the center of site. Reconfigure to roll toward Hayes and add additional plant material between fence and berm.  
Like willow dome.  
Like the many opportunities for play and the accommodations for a variety of ages.  
Like rain garden.

Concept C:

Prefer curved public walk to straight one.  
Entry plaza in leaf shape is a good idea but prefer to spend money on something with greater play value.  
Like tree house themed apparatus preferred over fairy tale theme of "A".  
Like raised tree house deck but be careful of damage to tree.  
Play area too small.

General Comments:

Provide 6' ornamental fence to north of soccer field instead of 4'.  
Mixed response to enclosing the play area. Could be uninviting vs. controlling movement of multiple children.  
Discuss site lighting options.
