Oak Park residents are invited to attend a Special Park Board Meeting to discuss the Site Master Plan at Field Center/Park.

Major improvements to the baseball and soccer fields and playground will be made to Field Park beginning on July 9. A new path, picnic shelter, splash pad and bocce ball court are also part of the Field Park Renovation Project as well as a new vehicular drop-off on the west side, bike racks, drinking fountains, benches and landscaping.

The project will require removing 14 trees and relocating 9 trees. There will be 77 new trees planted and 56 trees will remain and be protected during the project.

It is anticipated that Field Park will be closed beginning July 9, 2007 through the tentative completion date of November 26, 2007.

Field Center will be closed from July 9, 2007 through early September 2007.
