



Is There Spring in Your Step?

We have nearly made it through the winter months and soon spring will have sprung. It's time to dig into your closet and find your walking shoes to enjoy some fresh air. Did you know that for every mile a sedentary person walks adds an additional seven minutes to their life? The Park District offers a variety of scenic parks which you can walk all the way around to get your walking program off to a good start. Here are some locations and distances from which to choose:

- Barrie Park .32 miles (while you're there, climb the hill for a great workout)
- Euclid Square Park .25 miles (park renovation begins in July)
- Longfellow Park .33 miles (the newly renovated park features a new basketball and splash pad areas)
- Taylor Park .46 miles (our 2nd largest park, originally designed by noted architect Jens Jensen)

If you want to do a little more walking or hop on your bike, try one of these excursions.

- Austin Gardens to Lindberg Park 2.1 miles roundtrip
- Barrie Park to Euclid Square Park 1.8 miles roundtrip
- Field Park to Taylor Park 1.3 miles roundtrip
- Longfellow Park to Euclid Square Park 2.2 miles roundtrip
- Lindberg Park to Taylor Park 1.4 miles roundtrip
- Maple Park to Fox Park 2.3 miles roundtrip
- Stevenson Park to Andersen Park 1.8 miles roundtrip
- Taylor Park to Ridgeland Common 2.0 miles roundtrip

For those who are even more ambitious, how about one of these loops that tour Oak Park's parks?

- Austin Gardens to Mills Park to Scoville Park and back to Austin Gardens is 1.3 miles!
- Rehm Park to Euclid Square Park to Carroll Park to Maple Park to Barrie Park and back to Rehm Park is 3.6 miles!
- Rehm Park to Euclid Square Park to Carroll Park to Maple Park to Barrie Park to Longfellow Park to Fox Park to Wenonah Tot Lot to Oak Park Conservatory and back to Rehm Park is a whopping 5.3 miles!
