



Oak Park Conservatory Photography Policy

Professional photographers are welcome to use the Oak Park Conservatory facility for photo shoots once the proper permit application has been completed. A permit should be completed at least one week prior to the event. To acquire a permit application, call the Oak Park Conservatory at 708.386.4700. Tripods are not allowed when the Conservatory is open to the public.

Open Hours:

Tuesday through Sunday from 10 am until 4 pm

Monday from 2 until 4 pm

The Park District Code Rules and Regulations Governing the Use of Park District Facilities for Private Enterprise states:

7.16 Private Instruction, Retail and Commercial Uses Prohibited. No person shall (a) conduct or engage in any private instruction, lesson, class, or similar activity or undertaking or (b) engage in any retail or commercial use at or in any Park Facility at any time except as previously approved by the Park District or where designated in a Use Permit.

Permit Cost:

Residents – \$50/hour during open hours

\$100/hour outside of open hours

Non-residents - \$60/hour during open hours

\$120/hour outside of open hours
