- Dole Center, 2nd Floor, 255 Augusta. (Dole Center has a lobby on the second floor for comfortable waiting.)

Adult Trips Refund Policy:

If a trip is cancelled by the Park District, a full refund will be issued. If you cancel your participation in a trip, refunds require the approval of the Superintendent of Recreation or his/her designee. If your registration can be filled by another patron from a waitlist, your fee will be refunded with only the service fee withheld. Unrecoverable costs (i.e., advance ticket purchases, meal purchases, etc) will be added to the service fee.
