## Orienteering (Ages 10+) JG

Orienteering is a challenging activity that involves navigating through the outdoors with just a map and a compass. Learn the basics of orienteering on a day hike at Waterfall Glen Forest Preserve in Darien. Your group can go off on your own and hike at your own pace or stay with the trip leader as you explore the hilly terrain while viewing a diversity of plant and animal habitats and learning about the history of the area.
