

"Mi Escuela" - Spanish Preschool Program

Registration for the 2009-2010 school year began on Monday, Jan 5, 2009, in-person at the Park District Office, 218 Madison, for the programs below.

Mi Escuela (My School) JP Spanish Preschool Program (Ages 3-5) *Non-lottery program*

Children can acquire a second language and improve their English skills. This is a unique opportunity to prepare your child for a multi-lingual future. Lessons will be taught in both Spanish and English each day, with more Spanish being used as the school year progresses. During free play children will be exposed to toys and art activities related to a particular theme. When starting a new theme, Spanish and English vocabulary from previous themes will be reinforced.

Participants must be at least 3 (by August 31, 2009)

A birth certificate and \$25 non-refundable registration fee plus first month's tuition is required for registration.

Mi Escuela Kinder PM (My School) JP Spanish Preschool Program (Ages 4-5) *Non-lottery program*

Mi Escuela Kinder will expand upon the child's past Spanish learning experiences. Spanish will be the primary language of instruction. Children will be exposed to general themes or activities related to Math, Language Arts, Simple Science, Small Motor Skills, Art and Music. Free time will encourage learning in all aspects of the classroom. During this time, children will play with puzzles and a variety of toys and games. Group time and music will be full of Language Arts activities, such as puppets, flannel board stories, books, guessing games, songs, movement activities and fingerplay. Children will have work time to complete their arts and crafts activities individually.

Playschool (Ages 2-3½) JP

Non-lottery program, registration began with previous brochure, only one class still available!

Children enjoy an unstructured but stimulating environment in which to play together, dress up, pretend, build with blocks, master a puzzle, and make new friends. Each class will include a short group time with a story, singing, creative movement, or musical instruments. Children will take turns providing the snacks. All participants must be 2 years old by the first day of class.

Preschool 2009-2010

Participants in preschool MUST be toilet-trained.

Registration for the 2009-2010 school year is accepted in-person at the Park District Office, 218 Madison, for Preschool and Jr. Kindergarten. Programs below begin the week of August 31, 2009. **All registrations must be accompanied by a birth certificate, an updated immunization form, and a non-refundable \$25 registration fee plus the first month's tuition.**

Preschool Program (Ages 3-5) JP

Children are involved in a variety of activities including social interaction, free play, creative arts and crafts, singing and rhythm activities, stories, fingerplay, role playing, large and small motor skills activities, and activities related to everyday math and science discovery. Students will be exposed to colors, numbers, letters, and shapes. Children must be 3 years old and toilet trained before entering school

Junior Kindergarten Program

(Ages 4-5) JP

This program is specifically designed for those children who have late birthdays and miss the September 1 cut-off for entrance to kindergarten. Children must be 4, but not 5 years old by September 1, 2009, and may not be enrolled in kindergarten. Junior Kindergarten expands upon the child's preschool experience to help him/her prepare for kindergarten. Weekly themes will be used to organize social and academic experiences to strengthen their kindergarten readiness skills, which include, but are not limited to, alphabet letters, numbers, shapes, colors, names, addresses, telephone numbers and self-help skills. Free play, art, group table time, songs, stories, body movement, play acting, daily outdoor play and simple math and science experiences are included in the curriculum.
