Ceramics

Instructor: E. Linne

Comic Book Making

Printmaking

Instructor: N. Fong

From monotype to multiples, we will learn different printmaking techniques and terminology as we pull prints. Students must be mature and responsible for this program as we use sharp tools to create our prints. Fee: \$175/\$263

Ceramics
