Spend your summer doing something positive both for Oak Park youth and yourself! Besides helping kids in your community have a great summer, being a CIT always looks great on a resume and may even help you get a paid camp counselor position in the future. CITs will spend Monday-Friday with their assigned park district camps, working with youth, leading games and crafts, and assisting on field trips. On Thursday afternoons, all CITs will help walk Extended Campers to Ridgeland Common and then meet with the rest of the CITs to discuss their experiences and receive additional training from 3:30-5pm. All CITs will be required to attend mandatory training from 6-8pm, May 5, 7, 12, and 14, at Stevenson Center. Teens who participated in past CIT sessions may be exempt from some of the training dates (contact the CIT Coordinator to be certain). Teens should register for the camp location and session they are interested in. Please note that while camps will not meet on F, Jul 3, this camp will not be prorated.
