

# Pool Passes

## Pool Entry Fees

Fees are per person (ages 1 & older)/per session. This is a gate admission and any individual who enters the facility is required to purchase and present a pool pass or pay the daily fee.

## Ridgeland Common Pool (415 Lake Street in Oak Park)

Ridgeland Common Pool is one of the coolest places in town offering hours of summer fun for the whole community. All visitors are sure to find what they're looking for in one of Ridgeland Common's many amenities which include a 50-meter pool, an age 7 and under zero-edge wading pool with a spray-play apparatus, a diving well with 1 and 3-meter diving boards, an adult sun deck, plenty of shade on the pool deck, and a concession stand. Also available at Ridgeland Common Pool is an aquatic lift for persons with disabilities for easy pool entry and exit. Ridgeland Common Pool is ADA accessible.

## Rehm Park Pool (515 Garfield Street in Oak Park)

At Rehm Pool guests will enjoy a 50 meter zero-edge pool with spray-play apparatus, a separate wading pool for ages 6 years and under and a sand play area. This facility also features a diving well equipped with drop slides, one meter diving boards and a diving tower with five and seven meter platforms. An adult sun deck and a concession stand are also available at Rehm Pool as well as an aquatic lift for persons with disabilities for easy pool entry and exit. Rehm Pool is ADA accessible.



## General Pool Pass Info

Avoid paying the daily admission fee - purchase a season pass valid at both pool facilities. Pool passes are good for all family and public swimming sessions, giving you unlimited visits to the pool without having to pay the \$9 gate fee.

## Pool/Rink Combo Passes

A discounted combination pool and rink pass is available to Oak Park residents now through May 9, 2009. Individuals who purchase their rink pass for the next skating season, will receive approximately 10% off the regular prices. Rink passes are valid for the October 2009 through February 2010 rink season. In order to be eligible to take advantage of these great savings, an equal or greater number of pool passes must be purchased. To compute the combination price, add the cost of the rink pass to the cost of the pool pass.

## Lap Swim Passes

**Just for lap sessions - also available for purchase in combination with a pool pass (must be done in person)**

Good for all lap swimming sessions. A season lap pass gives you unlimited visits to lap swimming without having to pay the \$4 gate fee. Purchase a lap pass in combination with your swim pass to enjoy all the benefits the pool has to offer and receive a discount off the lap swim pass.

## Babysitters/child care provider passes

- ◆ If your child care provider lives in Oak Park but not at your residence, a resident individual pass can be purchased (or pay the \$9 admission fee).
- ◆ If your child care provider lives at your residence, then you can add him/her to your household with proof of residency (or pay the \$9 admission fee).
- ◆ If your child care provider is a non-resident, then you must purchase a non-resident individual pass or pay the \$9 admission fee.

## Resident Discount Passes - Oak Park Residents Only (See Below)

Swim occasionally, but don't want to pay for a season pass? Why not purchase a resident discount pass for \$14! This card entitles you to a discounted admission fee of \$6 per visit (instead of \$9 each time). This pass pays for itself within 5 visits to the pool! Proof of residency required (see below).

## Oak Park Proof of Residency

To take advantage of the reduced resident rates you must provide a driver's license or state ID with an Oak Park address. If you do not have either of those, you can choose TWO of the forms of identification below to prove your Oak Park address.

- telephone bill (cell phone bills will not be accepted)
- voter's registration card
- vehicle registration card
- Village of Oak Park vehicle sticker receipt

## How To Purchase A Pool And/Or Rink Pass

### Park District ID Card Information

In 2008, a new universal Park District ID card was introduced. This photo ID card may be used for any type of “membership” registration within the Park District (pool pass, discount card, skating pass, indoor playground, teen center, etc) after paying the appropriate fee.

### 2008 Pool or Rink Pass Holders

If you purchased a pool or rink pass in 2008, you DO NOT NEED to get a new Park District ID Card. Your 2008 Park District ID Card will automatically begin working once when we process your registration.

Your “membership” can be renewed if you wish to purchase the same household type as last year. Membership renewals can be done using one of the options below:

- using “Weby,” the Park District’s online registration system
- via fax using the registration form on page 82
- via mail-in using the registration form on page 82
- in person at Ridgeland Common or Hedges Administrative Center

If you wish to change the type of “membership” - such as going from a resident discount card to an individual pool membership - you can register using one of the options below:

- via fax using the registration form on page 82
- via mail-in using the registration form on page 82
- in person at Ridgeland Common or Hedges Administrative Center

### New Pass Purchaser

If you did not purchase a pool or rink pass for the 2008 season and wish to do so for 2009, you will need to register using one of the options below:

- via fax using the registration form on page 82
- via mail-in using the registration form on page 82
- in person at Ridgeland Common or Hedges Administrative Center

New pool passes CANNOT be purchased using “Weby,” the Park District’s online registration system. Once your registration has been processed, you can have your Park District Photo ID card taken in person at Ridgeland Common or the Hedges Administrative Center.

### A Note About Residency

If you are an Oak Park resident purchasing your pass in-person, you are required to show proof of residency (see requirements on previous page) in order to receive the resident discount. For those registering via fax or mail-in, the Park District will attempt to verify residency using an alternative source but you may be contacted to show proof of residency in person.
