### Paul Hruby Ice Arena at Ridgeland Common

Ridgeland Common's Paul Hruby Ice Arena provides Learn to Skate, Hockey, and Recreational Public Skating programs to the community. It is a seasonal rink in operation October through March. Information on classes and other programs will be available in August. We look forward to seeing you in the fall.

### Rink Passes

A discounted rink pass is available to Oak Park residents now through July 31, 2009. Individuals who purchase their rink pass for the next skating season, will receive approximately 10% off the regular prices. ## Learn to Swim Academy

### About Swim Lessons!

The Park District offers group and semi-private lessons. Swimming lessons are taught at all skill levels and ages to increase awareness in and around the water. The Park District program covers skills and knowledge in a logical progression for proficient aquatic skill development. Swimming lessons take place at either Rehm Pool or Ridgeland Common Pool. Your child's learning will benefit by registering for BOTH sessions!

### Refund policy for classes

Learn to swim and ice skating lessons require a one-week notice for a refund. If you cancel a program a week before the class starts, a refund will be issued minus a \$3 processing fee. Requests for refunds must be made by phone or in person. The Park District reserves the right to consolidate, postpone, or cancel programs with insufficient enrollment. A full refund will be issued in these situations.

### Class Make-up Policy

Due to the limited availability of make-up days we will be holding all scheduled lessons unless there are extreme weather conditions. Any class that is cancelled due to extreme weather, i.e. thunder and lightning, will be rescheduled - day to be announced. Please call Ridgeland Common before your scheduled lesson time to verify that lessons will be held.

### Observation Policy

Parents **ARE NOT PERMITTED** on the main pool decks during class time. The Adult Sun Deck and Concession Deck at Ridgeland and Rehm will be open for observation by parents.

### Baby Pool Policy

The baby pools at Ridgeland Common and Rehm Pool will be closed to the public during all scheduled swimming lessons. The pool is reserved for instruction during this time.

**Important Note About Registering For Swim Lessons**

Learn To Swim classes were listed in the spring brochure and were included in the spring program lottery. As a result, some classes are full with waiting lists. These programs are listed in this brochure because the Park District may add new class sections depending on demand and instructor availability. Also, spaces may become available when participants are moved up to higher levels and/or necessary changes to classes are made. We offer the option of being placed on a waiting list in an attempt to accommodate as many students as possible in our Learn to Swim program. ### Ridgeland Common Pool (415 Lake Street in Oak Park)

Ridgeland Common Pool's many amenities include a 50-meter pool, an age 7 and under zero-edge wading pool with a spray-play apparatus, a diving well with 1 and 3-meter diving boards, an adult sun deck, plenty of shade on the pool deck, and a concession stand, plus an aquatic lift for persons with disabilities for easy pool entry and exit. ADA Accessible!

### Rehm Park Pool (515 Garfield St. in Oak Park)

At Rehm Pool guests will enjoy a 50 meter zero-edge pool with spray-play apparatus, a separate wading pool for ages 6 years and under, a sand play area, a diving well equipped with drop slides, one meter diving boards, a diving tower with five and seven meter platforms, an adult sun deck, a concession stand and an aquatic lift for persons with disabilities for easy pool entry and exit. Rehm Pool is ADA accessible.
